

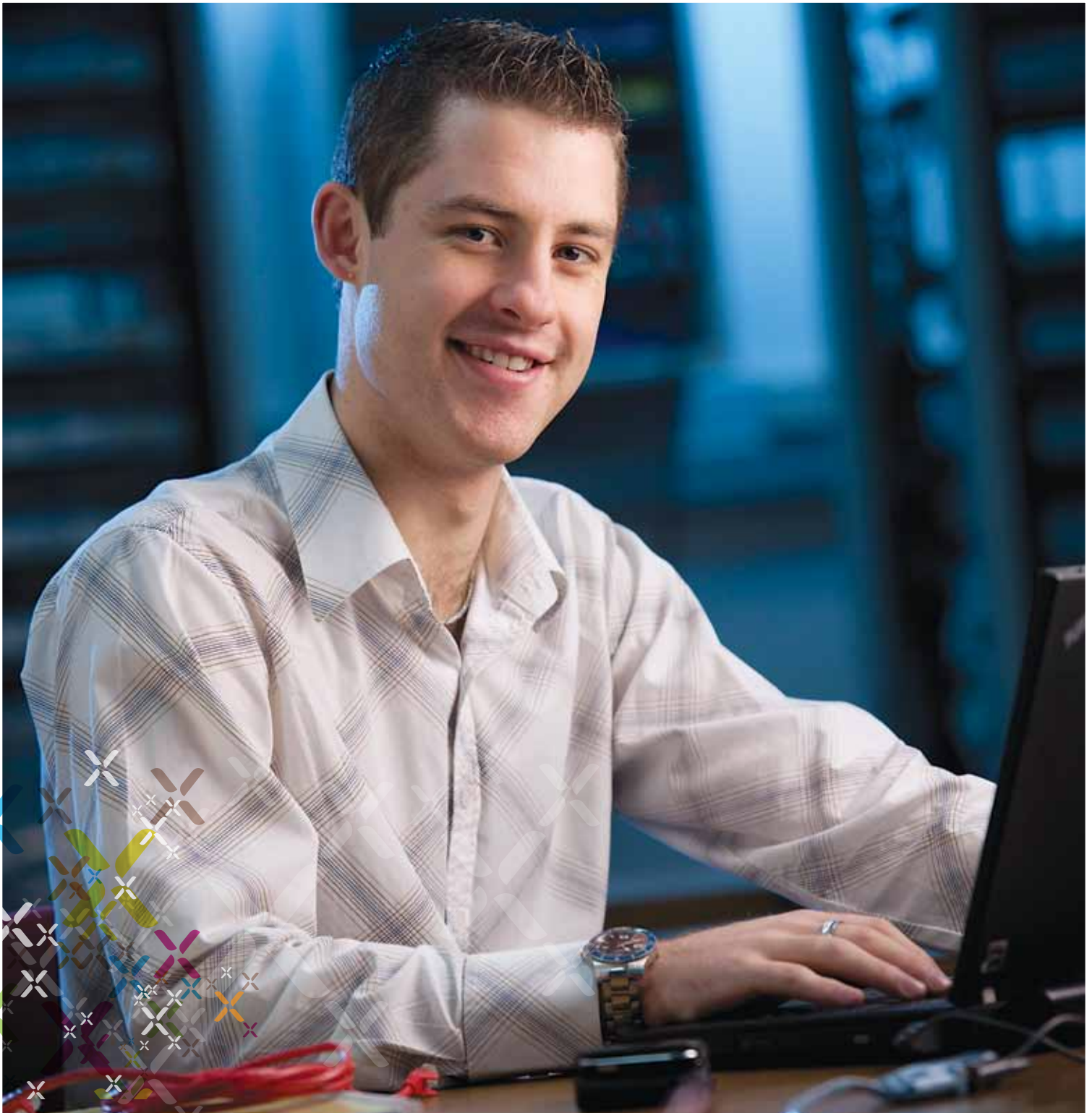

# Learning Pathways at Box Hill Institute

Box Hill Institute has a long and successful history of building on its strengths in tertiary education by working with students to optimise their educational opportunities. The Institute recognises that students who start a qualification at Box Hill have opportunities to continue their studies through to the highest level possible. It is with this in mind that Box Hill Institute offers courses that cater to a wide variety of skill levels, workforce experiences and academic interests.

The relationships a student forms with teaching staff can set the foundations of their future career paths. It is important, therefore, to ensure that every student is given opportunities to continue their studies on a path that suits their individual learning interests and career goals. Box Hill Institute aims to provide students with a variety of options for articulation into higher level courses. That's why the Institute provides clear and guaranteed pathways between certificates and diplomas, into advanced diploma and degree courses, for all students who successfully begin their learning journey through enrolling in a certificate level qualification.

While for many students, a common entry point might remain a certificate level course, students are increasingly opting to begin their tertiary studies at Box Hill Institute whilst still in secondary school by choosing a VET in Schools (VETiS) program. Upon successful completion of a VETiS course, students are guaranteed entry into a certificate qualification. While the VETiS program provides an excellent example of the range of articulation pathway options available to students at Box Hill Institute, this concept of 'value adding' to career options is not only for secondary school students. Anybody who undertakes training at the Institute and successfully completes a lower level qualification will be guaranteed<sup>1</sup> entry into the higher level course if they choose to take up this option.

The Institute has successfully assisted many students to follow their chosen path to higher level qualifications, however this guarantee of progression from certificate to diploma and diploma to degree will ensure that we continue to meet the educational needs of future students at Box Hill Institute.

1. Entry into all courses is contingent on factors such as availability and the successful completion of all requirements for award of the lower level qualification. Discipline specific entry requirements may also apply.

For example, a student wishing to pursue a career in the hospitality industry can enrol in the Certificate II in Hospitality whilst still at secondary school. Upon successful completion of the course they will be guaranteed entry into the Certificate IV in Hospitality. Students who wish to continue their studies in hospitality will then have guaranteed entry into the Diploma of Hospitality course. Upon successful completion of this qualification students would be guaranteed a place in the Bachelor of Hospitality Management.

It is important to note that there is no time limit on such pathway options. Students often seek to exit formal study in order to gain experience in the workforce, making 'real world' use of their qualifications and may make the decision a few years down their career path to return to complete a higher qualification.
